As proposed by Board Member Perla Tabares Hantman, District 4, the Miami-Dade School Board unanimously voted to have the Superintendent report on the status of the Ad Hoc Multilingual Task Force 2007 recommendations, which include the need to increase the language proficiency of students in order to prepare them to compete in a global market.

"We are constantly striving to provide the best education and services to our students, as well as reviewing the progress of our programs and operations," said Hantman. "These are measures we can take to further our mission."

The Task Force also explored the feasibility of implementing a foreign language requirement from kindergarten through grade 12.
