The School Board unanimously approved two Resolutions proposed by District 4 Board Member, Perla Tabares Hantman at its regular meeting this week. The items honored three Miami-Dade County Public Schools educators recognized by the Florida Art Education Association, and a member of the District's Audit Committee for her years of service.

Ms. Amos served as a member of the Miami-Dade County Public Schools Audit Committee since 2004, including serving as Chair and Vice Chair. Ms. Amos' responsibilities have included assisting and advising the School Board and the Superintendent of Schools on matters pertaining to fiscal management of the school district, reviewing financial information to ensure that the District's overall audit coverage was sufficient, and ensuring that an adequate system of internal control was practiced.
