School Board Member Perla Tabares Hantman, District 4, nominated Carlos Artime, Principal of Barbara Goleman Senior High School, to receive "The Cervantes Outstanding Educator Award" presented by Nova Southeastern University's Fischler School of Education and Human Services at an event honoring Miami-Dade County Educators who have made significant contributions to promoting excellence in the education of Hispanic students. The Award Ceremony was held on October 15, at 6 p.m. at the Hilton Miami Downtown, 1601 Biscayne Blvd., Miami.

"As the principal of Barbara Goleman Senior High School, for the past five years, Mr. Artime has been successful at improving student academic performance as evidenced by impressive learning gains and by receiving the distinction of being the only public high school in Miami-Dade County to achieve the Federal Government's No Child Left Behind most stringent academic criteria of meeting Adequate Yearly Progress." Mr. Artime, who is the co-author of an alternative education program aimed at improving the academic deficiencies of struggling Hispanic students, also developed a values curriculum that was implemented for at-risk students during his tenure as an assistant principal at West Miami Middle School.

"Mr. Carlos Artime has been dedicated to the noble profession of education for the past 17 years. During his career, he has worked enthusiastically to improve the quality of education of students within the Miami-Dade County Public Schools," said Ms. Hantman.
