The School Board unanimously approved three items proposed by Board Chair Perla Tabares Hantman recognizing the three winners of the 2013 WalkSafe Poster Contest, a national children's safety initiative and a global environmental program, all of which are among the subjects near and dear to Ms. Hantman.

The Board voted to:

- Recognize the first-place winners in three grade-level categories – **Sean Capetillo**, Oliver Hoover Elementary School, Grades K-1 winner; **Bianca Chung**, Jack D. Gordon Elementary School, Grades 2-3 winner; and **Fabio Fernandez**, Oliver Hoover Elementary School, Grades 4-5 winner.
- Proclaim the month of April 2014 as Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Month.
- Endorse April 22, 2014 as *Earth Day* in Miami-Dade County Public Schools.
